

## **Patron Activity**

Purpose:

Create a count of **patrons** who checked out more than one item within a specified time period. By selecting the options below, you can show a trend of more patrons using your library each year. (hopefully!)

Location:

STAFFWEB REPORTS tab > Patron Activity.

Setup Options:

- Basic tab change report name and title to reflect purpose of report.
  a. Sample: DLFN High Patron Activity since 8/1/2015
- 2. User Selection tab select user profiles to be included.
  - a. Sample: STUDENT3 and FACULTY1



- 3. Patron Activity tab
  - a. Select Activity type (High or Low)
  - b. Set Activity Threshold
  - c. Set Activity Period to Yearly
  - d. Set Number of Periods
  - e. Set Starting from date
  - f. Select Library

Sample selections noted here will report any patrons with a FACULTY1 and STUDENT3 profile with 1 or more checkouts over a specific 6-year period (8/1/2015-current). You will be able to see over that 6-year period how many patrons circulated 1 or more items.

Viewing the Results:

- In Finished Reports, select the report and click the VIEW button.
- You only need the "View Result" checkbox to be selected.
- Using the "Style Sheet Report (HTML)" will open the results in a web browser.
- Using the "Style Sheet Comma Separated Values (CSV)" will open the results in your spreadsheet software (Excel, Libre Office Calc Spreadsheet, etc).



• Select SUPPRESS USER DETAIL as this will give you summary of each of the user profiles that used the library selected.
