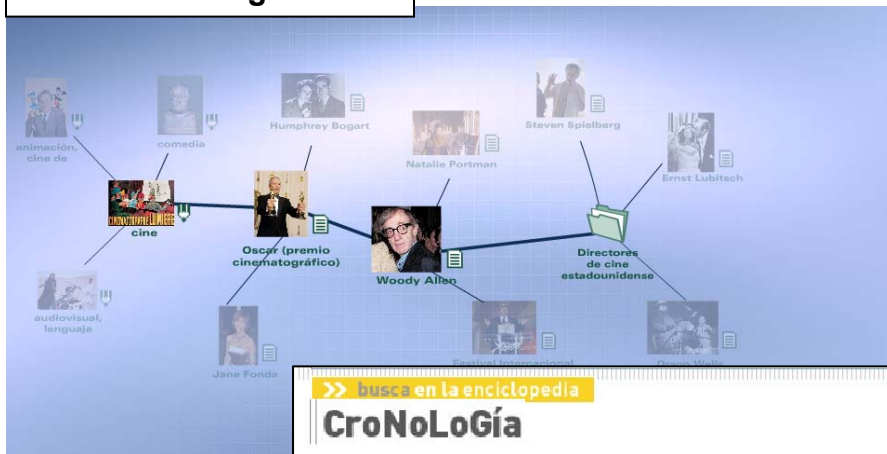
- Click on *Resources for Grades 9-12 or Core Collection*.

Timeline feature helps students develop a historical perspective through interactive research.

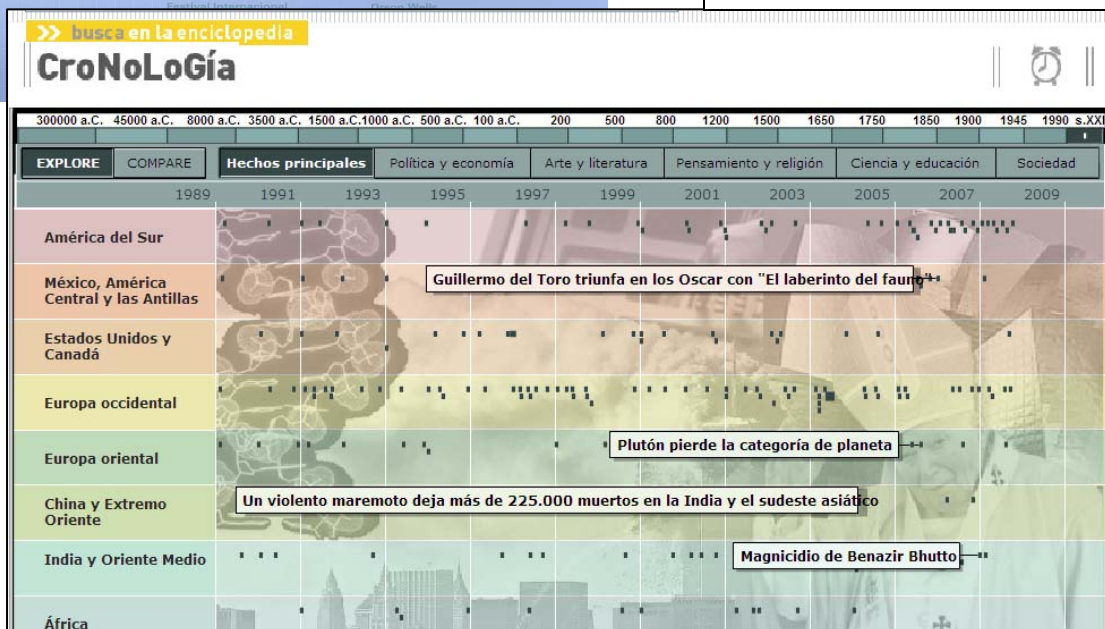
A visual navigation tool helps students not proficient in the language find the topic they're looking for.
