Grade Level Indicator: Determine “how many” in sets (groups) of 10 or fewer objects.

Search Steps:

1. Find the INFOhio site www.infohio.org.
2. Click on the *Resources for Grades K-5* button.
3. Click on the *Searchasaurus* button as shown below.



4. Enter your local username if prompted for authentication. Your teacher, librarian, or technology coordinator will have this information.
5. Click on *Searchasaurus* again.
6. Click on *Primary Search*.
7. Type in the search space provided: ***numbers and counting***.
8. Click on the *Search* button.
9. Click on the title *How Many* from *Turtle*, March/April 2005.
10. Click on the page image link and print the image shown.
11. Do the counting activity provided with the children.

Additional Comments on Search Process:

1. In the program *Searchasaurus* you can use the words ***AND***, ***OR*** or ***NOT*** between your search words to narrow or broaden your search.
2. The wildcard symbol is ***?***. You can use this in the middle of a word if you are not sure of the spelling.
3. The truncation symbol is *******. Use this by entering a root word and ending it with an *******.
