Search Steps:

1. Type www.infohio.org in the address bar and hit *Enter*.
2. Select *Resources for Grades 6-8* or *Core Collection*.
3. At this time, you may need to login to INFOhio using the Username and Password provided by your teacher or librarian. Press *Enter* or click *Submit*.
If you are already logged in, simply skip this step.
4. Select the *Oxford Reference Online* button.
5. Select the *Oxford Reference Online* button to enter the resource site.
6. In the quick search box, type in *honesty*. Select *Enter* or hit *Go*.
7. Click on the blue *Quotations* folder tab along the top of the results page.
8. Choose a quotation that will support your essay.

Additional Comments on Search Process:

1. Try selecting the *Widen Your Search* button in the upper right hand corner for additional searching tips.
2. Also, read the *Search Tips* button in the upper right hand corner for Boolean operators and truncation symbols.
