### Search Steps:

1. Go to the INFOhio Web site, [www.infohio.org](http://www.infohio.org).
2. Must authenticate as needed by entering your username and password. (If you are entering from home, obtain password from the librarian.)
3. Select *Resources for Grades 6-8*.
4. Select *SIRS Discoverer*.
5. Select *World Almanac for Kids* in the reference box.
6. Select *Keyword Search*.
7. Type *bill becomes a law*.
8. Click *Search*.
9. Select *How a Bill Becomes a Law* from the *World Almanac for Kids 2006*.
10. A text diagram of the steps taken for a bill to become a law is displayed.
11. Print for references.
