You want to write to your family and let them know about the ancient giant frog bones that were discovered in Madagascar. Use the NewsBank American Newspapers database to locate a newspaper article that mentions this article to mail with your letter. Show me what you found on your computer screen. **Article should mention Madagascar is where the bones of this giant frog were found.**

The president of Madagascar will be flying in to meet your tribe this evening. Use the EbscoHost Student Research Center to find out his name. Show me what you found on your computer screen. **Article should mention President Marc Ravalomanana**

You are wondering what the chief food crop of Madagascar is. Use the World Book Encyclopedia Online Reference Center to find out. Show me what you found on your computer screen. **Rice is the main food crop of Madagascar.**

On your latest exploration, you discovered Madagascar is an island. Use the quick search within Oxford Reference Online to discover what large continent Madagascar lies closest to. Show me what you found on your computer screen. **Madagascar is large subtropical island lying off the coast of southern Africa.**

A plant identification book will help you find which foods are safe to eat. Locate a plant identification book and show the book to me. **Any plant ID book will work**

The tribe is sick of eating rice. Since rice is plentiful, you must eat it often. Find a cookbook with a creative recipe that uses rice. Show me the recipe in a cookbook (not on the computer). **Any recipe that calls for rice**

You need the addresses of movie producers so you can propose making a movie of your experiences on the island. Don't pull the book off the shelf, just tell me the call number of an address book in our library you could use. **REF 338.7 LEV or REF 917.3 LEV**

Find a fiction book by Will Hobbs, using the online card catalog. His adventure stories may help you prepare for what's ahead. Pull the book from the shelf and show it to me. **Any Hobbs fiction book**

You are lost on the island of Madagascar. Find an atlas that shows the topography of the land. Show me the page that will help you find your way. **Just so the map shows the land forms and is of Madagascar (topography maps show colors to represent sea level, mountains, etc)**

Yesterday you spotted a dugong. Is it an endangered species? Show me where in The World Almanac and Book of Facts book you found the answer. **Yes (look up animals in the general index then go to the endangered page to find the answer in the chart)**

Before leaving for this adventure you used a print almanac to find out how rainy the island would be. However, the closest town you could find in the almanac was Cape Town, Africa. What is the average annual precipitation of Cape Town, Africa? Show me where you found the answer in the book. **20.5 inches (look up precipitation in general index; go to international page to find answer in the chart)**

You are so sick of hearing your tribe talk about how "tired" they are. Use a thesaurus to find other words to enhance their vocabulary. Have each member of your tribe tell me a different synonym for tired. **Clapped-out; fatigued, jaded, wearied, weary, worn, worn-down, worn-out**
