Additional Updates from INFOhio

BLUEcloud

ISearch/Fetch

- ISearch updates:
 - The Home Library button is displayed if the All Library button is clicked.
 - A material type icon is now displayed.
 - The results are now larger and clearer.
 - My List now includes call numbers.
 - Improved genre display.
 - Search by ISBN number and Series.
- Fetch updates:
 - There have been improvements to accessibility.
 - Book covers have better images.
 - Simpler messages are displayed for easier understanding.

SymphonyWeb

- Updates completed:
 - Will support multiple tabs open.
 - Copy and Past field is now active.
 - Column widths are now resizable.
- Updates in Process:

- Custom sounds for alerts.
- Font size to be changed.
- Search results when scrolling displayed.
- The Symphony Web Pilot has been extended. Current participants can continue for 2 years upon requesting continuance in the pilot. If you did not participate in the initial pilot, to be a part of the next pilot your school must meet equity requirements in order to participate in the extended 2 year pilot. If your school is on the list of top 50 qualifying schools you will be contacted. Once the pilot is over you will still have access to Workflows and BLUEcloud. The benefits of the program include completely web based, the servers are hosted by INFOhio, and SymphonyWeb can be accessed by multiple devices.

BLUEcloud Course Lists and Text Sets

- BLUEcloud Course Lists is a resource list management tool. The list is typically made by librarians of several different material types. These lists can then be used by teachers to make Text Sets.
- INFOhio Text Sets are groups of texts or media on the same topic and theme. They are built on a Quad Text Set Framework. There are currently 10 sets available that are ready made, a template has been provided to allow new sets to be created. These sets include scaffolding for students, background knowledge, activities, and much more.
